PRELUDIUM STRINGS (introductory level string ensemble) NEW THIS SEASON!

Provides an introduction to orchestral performance for string players reading and playing at or above **Grade 1 RCM or Suzuki Book I**. *The playing levels are suggested guidelines only*

Rehearsals: Tuesdays, 4:45 – 5:45 pm, Late September through April.

Conductor: David Wadley

Registration Requirements: Qualified candidates please submit the application. There are no auditions for the Beginning Strings candidates. Just submit the application and show up to the “Open House” rehearsal, on Tuesday, September 22, 4:45 – 5:45 pm.

Fee: \$295 due at the rehearsal on **September 29** along with completed membership form (distributed at the Open House). Half of the fee may be in the form of postdated cheque for January 15, 2010. Cheques payable to KW Symphony.

YOUTH STRINGS (junior level string ensemble)

Provides an orchestral performance instruction for string players with some ensemble experience, reading and playing at or above **Grade 3 RCM or Suzuki Book III**.

YOUTH ORCHESTRA (advanced level symphony orchestra)

In addition to the activities listed above, the candidates will have an opportunity to compete in the annual Concerto Competition. Applicants should play at or above **Grade 8 RCM or Suzuki Book VII (Strings)**.

VALHALLA BRASS (intermediate to advanced level brass ensemble)

Combining the powerful orchestral brass section with the intimacy of chamber music, the Valhalla Brass consists of trumpets, French horns, tenor and bass trombones, euphonium, tuba and percussion. Applicants should play at or above **Grade 6 RCM**. Advanced candidates may audition for Valhalla Brass exclusively or combined with YO.

Rehearsals: Sundays, 3:30 - 4:30pm, September - April, Wilfrid Laurier University, Faculty of Music.
Conductor: Trevor Wagler

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS: Prepare two contrasting pieces or two contrasting movements of your choice. You may be asked to sight-read. If you audition for Youth Orchestra, you will not need to re-audition for the Valhalla Brass. No accompanists are required or allowed at the auditions. Auditions are scheduled for September 12 (afternoon) at Wilfrid Laurier University, Faculty of Music.

The YOP Coordinator will contact you with an audition time after the application has been received.

The Fee: \$295 due at the rehearsal on **September 20** along with completed membership form (distributed at the auditions). Half of the fee may be in the form of postdated cheque for January 15, 2010. Cheques payable to KW Symphony

CHAMBER MUSIC PROGRAM (available for all levels)

This program provides chamber music instruction for all instrumentalists, candidates for small ensembles (trios, quartets, etc.). The instruction will focus on leadership and abilities to follow, teamwork, active listening and exploring a wide range of chamber music repertoire. The main coaches of CMP are members of Bremen String Quartet. The CMP concert will be scheduled towards the end of the season; other opportunities will include outreach events and CITS lobby performances. The fee per participant: \$15 / session. Cheques payable to KW Symphony (submitted at the commencement of this program; the number of sessions TBD).
